MANDATE

The Mandate of The Task Force Organisation

Ensure people are represented by their governments.

ARTICLE I

Relating to the purpose of the Task Force Organisation

SECTION 1 - Relating to the entity name and purpose: The entity shall be known as “The Task Force Organisation” or TFO, colloquially known as, the “Task Force” and shall designate itself as a nongovernmental and not for profit organisation. Members of The Task Force Organisation shall be known as Task Force staffers. The Task Force shall ensure people are represented by their governments. To fulfil its mandate in specific areas, the Task Force shall establish and maintain missions, divisions and districts in nations, regions and territories that it determines appropriate to realise the Task Force Mandate.

SECTION 2 - Relating to the entity mission statement and slogan: The Task Force shall establish its mission statement to be, “Ensure people are represented by their governments.” The Task Force shall establish its slogan to be “Representation. Everywhere. Everytime.”

SECTION 3 - Relating to the structural elements of the Task Force: The Task Force shall consist of seven primary structural elements:

1. The Task Force Order
2. The Task Force Division for Legislative Affairs
3. The Task Force Division for Constituent Affairs
4. The Task Force Division for Communications
5. The Task Force Division for Appropriations
6. The Task Force Division for Operations
7. The Task Force Alliance System

ARTICLE II

Relating to the structure of The Task Force Organisation

SECTION 1 - Relating to the purpose and organisation of the Task Force Order: The Task Force Order shall be the primary administrative authority of the Task Force. The Order shall direct the operations of The Task Force Organisation and shall contend with all matters regarding The Task Force Organisation, its management, as well as the management and dissolution of its assets. The Order shall comprise of all seven legally designated voting members of The Task Force Organisation board of directors and all Order members shall convene on a monthly basis. The Order shall be facilitated by the Chair to the Order, who shall be chosen by the members of the Order and shall direct the Order’s operations and have the ability to convene emergency meetings with respect to the other members of the Order. The members of the Order shall advise and, or, direct the various primary structural elements of the Task Force. A member of the Order may be disbanded by a unanimous-minus-one vote of the other Order members. Decisions by the Order shall be made with a two-thirds majority vote, with each Order member having one vote.

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Relating to the position and duties of the Chief of Staff to the Task Force: The Chief of Staff shall be the official chief executive to The Task Force Organisation and shall be appointed by the Order. The Chief of Staff shall be tasked with the following responsibilities:

1. Coordinating all Task Force initiatives and efforts;
2. Administrating the Task Force, its operations, staffers, and assets;
3. Authorising the recruitment and disbandment of Task Force staffers;
4. Enforcing the directives of the Order;
5. Responding to concerns raised by the Staff Assembly;
6. Representing the interests of The Task Force Organisation and its members;
7. Protecting the Mandate of The Task Force Organisation;

Relating to the purpose and organisation of the Staff Assembly: The Staff Assembly shall be composed of all staffers currently serving in The Task Force Organisation as well as all staffers formerly in The Task Force Organisation who have been honourably disbanded. The Staff Assembly shall function as a legislative body and shall advise the Order and Chief of Staff. The Staff Assembly shall be administered by the Order which shall facilitate and fulfil the operations of the Staff Assembly. The Staff Assembly shall appoint members to the Order, by simple majority vote. Recommendations by the Staff Assembly shall be made with a simple majority vote, with each Staff Assembly member having one vote.

SECTION 2 - Relating to the purpose and organisation of the Task Force Division for Legislative Affairs: The Division shall be the element primarily responsible for directing all legislative initiatives pursued by the Task Force. The Division shall work to draft, endorse, advocate for, and work to pass legislative initiatives that the Task Force pursues. The Division shall be administered by the Director of Legislative Affairs, who shall direct the operations of the Division.

SECTION 3 - Relating to the purpose and organisation of the Task Force Division for Constituent Affairs: The Division shall be the element primarily responsible for representing the interests of the public. The Division shall furthermore be responsible for the collection, curation and analysis of Task Force data and reports. The Division shall be administered by the Director of Constituent Affairs, who shall direct the operations of the Division.

SECTION 4 - Relating to the purpose and organisation of the Task Force Division for Communications: The Division shall be the element primarily responsible for communication between The Task Force and members of the public, media agencies, as well as other public entities. The Division shall be administered by the Director of Communications, who shall direct the operations of the Division.

SECTION 5 - Relating to the purpose and organisation of the Task Force Division for Appropriations: The Division shall be the element primarily responsible for the obtainment and appropriation of funds and assets managed by The Task Force Organisation. The Division shall be administered by the Director of Appropriations, who shall direct the operations of the Division.

SECTION 6 - Relating to the purpose and organisation of the Task Force Division for Operations: The Division shall be the element primarily responsible for the effective operation of

The Task Force Organisation

The Task Force Organisation, the management of internal and legal affairs, as well as the management of Task Force records. The Division shall be administered by the Director of Operations, who shall direct the operations of the Division.

SECTION 7 - Relating to the purpose and organisation of the Task Force Alliance System: The Alliance System shall be the element primarily responsible for the representation of Task Force initiatives with all governmental, nongovernmental, intergovernmental, corporate, religious, and other persons or entities who have established and maintain cooperative relations with the Task Force. The Alliance System shall be administered by the Ambassador of the Alliance System, who shall facilitate and direct the operations of the Alliance System.

ARTICLE III

Relating to The Task Force Organisation Mandate

SECTION 1 - Relating to the Mandate of The Task Force Organisation: The Task Force Mandate shall take precedence over all other decisions made by entities of The Task Force Organisation and shall establish the organisational structure of the Task Force.

SECTION 2 - Relating to the ratification of the Task Force Mandate: The Task Force Mandate shall be ratified by a unanimous vote of the Order.

Relating to the amendment process of the Task Force Mandate: The Task Force Mandate may be amended with a unanimous vote by the Order.

Relating to the effective date of the Task Force Mandate: The Task Force Mandate shall take effect on the Twenty-Fourth of February, of the year Two-Thousand Twenty-Two and it shall remain in effect indefinitely following that date.

SECTION 2 - Relating to the Directives of The Task Force Organisation: On an annual basis, members of the Staff Assembly shall submit recommendations to the Order for adoption. These recommendations may pertain to the objectives, organisation or any other matters relating to the Task Force.

ARTICLE IV

Relating to the Membership of The Task Force Organisation

SECTION 1 - Relating to the definition of Task Force membership: A Task Force member is an individual authorised to serve as a staffer to The Task Force Organisation who works to fulfil its mandate in a capacity they have been appointed to carry out.

SECTION 2 - Relating to the membership eligibility requirements of the Task Force: Any individual seeking to become a Task Force staffer shall be willing to fulfil the Task Force mission and abide by its mandate; be willing to complete the assignments delegated to them by the Task Force to the best of their ability; be willing to abide by all conduct standards enacted by the Task Force; and shall work to progress the Task Force's objectives and not impede upon its progress.

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SECTION 3 - Relating to the recruitment and disbandment of Task Force members: The Chief of Staff shall be responsible for authorising the recruitment and disbandment of members. The Chief of Staff shall also consult with the Order regarding the recruitment and disbandment of members.

MANDATES

The Mandates of The Task Force Organisation

ONE - All Task Force staffers, current and former, who have been honourably disbanded, shall be entitled to participation in the Staff Assembly and every staffer shall be allotted one vote on the Staff Assembly.

TWO - All Task Force operations and campaigns shall be peaceful in nature and the Task Force shall condemn violence in all forms.

THREE - The Task Force shall not engage in, or endorse partisan activities, nor shall it affiliate itself with political parties, political candidates, or any other partisan faction.

FOUR - The Task Force shall only accept funding from members of the public, or sources which do not compromise the integrity and impartiality of the Task Force. Furthermore the Task Force shall rescind all funds offered from political entities.

FIVE - The Task Force shall not permit any form of discrimination on account of religion, race, ethnic background, national origin, gender affiliation or sexual orientation within it.

SIX - The Task Force shall remain transparent with the public regarding its objectives, initiatives, appropriations, ownership of funds and assets, as well as its decisions.

SEVEN - The official headquarters of the Task Force and any other central coordination units shall be located in a place designated by the Order.

By Mandate of The Task Force Order:


